

GENERAL QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Graduation is Saturday May 9, 2009, beginning at 10am, completing prior to 1pm.

There is a rehearsal, the evening before at Sagemont. It takes around an hour and one half.

This is a turn-key event- your fees pay for: Graduation building, ceremony, printing, programs, dvd of the ceremony, videographer, flowers, decorations, cap and gown, diploma and diploma cover, memory tassel, office personnel, Yearbook, photographer, photos of the Grad and parents and Class photo.

The only items not covered are: Honor Cords and Invitations (as not every Grad qualifies/desires)

Dates for payments and materials must be strictly adhered to and failure to do so could result in the Graduate not being allowed to participate in the Graduation ceremony.

Your cap and gown will be delivered to HEP, unless you purchase invitations from the Graduation Store, and then they will be delivered to the address you indicate.

You need to gather 10-12 photos of your Grad for the media show.

Your Grad should choose music for the media show and have it on a CD to be given to the videographer. It and your photos will be returned at Graduation.

Music must be pre-approved. HEP retains the right to disapprove any music selection presented.

A Senior photo will be taken for the yearbook and the Graduation program. Copies will be available for purchase, but there is not a charge for the program photo.

Your Graduate's music and pictures are played during Graduation along with a 90 second pre-recorded message delivered by your Grad.

The Parents' speech is 45 seconds long, inclusive, and is delivered "live." You do not have to give a speech, but are encouraged to "say a few words."

There will be another meeting in January. Most communication is accomplished via email.

Invitations are not included in the cost, but may be purchased by the group with a group discount.

You are not limited by the number of people you can invite.

You will be provided a “Date to Remember” sheet in January.

Deposit fee is \$100, non-refundable. Payment of deposit holds a place in the Graduation ceremony.
